**Emergency Housing Voucher (EHV) Program.** The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded a limited number of Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHV) to the Mobile Housing Authority (MHA).

**EHV Eligibility.** This program aids families and individuals who are:

1. Homeless;
2. At-risk of homelessness;
3. Fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking; or
4. Recently homeless and at considerable risk of housing instability.

Potentially eligible families and individuals must first complete an initial screening with a caseworker at the *Continuum of Care (CoC) Coordinated Entry System Agency*, **Housing First** or its delegate before referral to MHA. **Clients cannot apply directly to MHA for EHV assistance.**

The agencies making EHV referrals are:

- Housing First, Coordinated Entry Department
- Lifelines Counseling, Rape Crisis Center

Please note: Because a limited number of EHV's are available, families and individuals who meet the eligibility criteria must also satisfy additional prioritization criteria – established by the Continuum of Care. **Only eligible clients who are also in a priority group will be referred to MHA.**

All clients referred to MHA will then need to complete an EHV application for further screening and to verify eligibility for participation in the EHV program.
